United Way of Hastings 2nd Annual Stuff the Bus Helps Local Students

(HASTINGS, MN) The United Way of Hastings (UWH) is holding its 2nd Annual Stuff the Bus event August 19-26, 2019, to gather food items for students experiencing food insecurity during the weekends.

Food 4 Kids is an initiative of UWH in partnership with 360 Communities and ISD 200. Some students in Hastings don't have enough to eat. Weekends without school meals can be especially tough. Food 4 Kids provides bags of kid-friendly food to students for the weekend.

"Food 4 Kids helped feed nearly 150 Hastings students, each weekend, during the 2018-2019 school year," said Mari E. Mellick, CAE, Executive Director. "The Stuff the Bus event brings visibility to the need in our community and really helps us replenish our food supply so that we are ready when school begins." In addition to the school year, UWH helped kids this summer with weekend food bags and disseminated anywhere between 10 – 20 bags of food during the summer SPARK program.

The gallon food bags contain 6 food items (2 each of breakfast, lunch and dinner) for the weekend. All items are easy open (pop-top) cans or packages that are simple microwaveable foods that kids can prepare on their own if necessary.

Items needed include: Cereal – Individual Serving Boxes, Cereal Bars, Oatmeal Packets, Juice Boxes, Small Cans of Ravioli or Spaghettio's, Soup, Ramen Noodles, Individual Mac & Cheese Cups, Beef Sticks, Peanut Butter Packets, Any "Kid-Friendly" Food and Gallon Zip-Lock Bags for packing.
