- First guarter 2023, Dakota County seized more illicit pills than the entire year of 2022. And, 2022. seizures totaled more than the last 20 years combined!
- #1 cause of death amongst 18 45-year-olds is fentanyl poisoning. That's more deaths by opioids/ fentanyl than deaths by covid, suicide, car accidents, or gun violence for 18 – 45-year-olds.
- ONE death is too many.
